






SCIENCE NIGHT

BUILT-IN ROOMS - MATERIAL



The sound absorbing panel is made of thick fabric material, its size is 1,4 x 3 meters, they can be simply attached to each other. A truss frame is rigged from the ceiling grid system in a square or rectangular shape and the sound absorbing panels are then attached to the trusses. The meeting room height may be 4,4 meter or 6 meters. Height is depending on the size of the room and height of the hall in which the rooms are built. The **panels are covered with fire-proof black curtain from inside and also from outside** – this is primarily for decoration purpose.

The ceiling of the room is also covered with a sound absorbing fabric which is stretched over the room. This is to avoid sound reflection from the hall metal ceiling structure. Additional truss(es) in the center are keeping the ceiling fabric straight.


Air conditioning or ventilation is led into the rooms in order to ensure the proper temperature and fresh air during the conference. Entrances are double doors, supporting the room to stay soundproof. The printable framing surrounding the entrance doors can be used for tailor designed event branding. Carpeting of chosen colors, house light, and air conditioning are included in the basic room set-up.
